



St. Luke's-Elks Rehab Sports Physical Therapy Residency Program

St. Luke's-Elks Rehab is accepting applications for its Sports Physical Therapy Residency Program. The program begins each August, concluding after 12 months of mentorship in both clinical and academic settings.

The residency program provides physical therapists an opportunity to increase competency in sports physical therapy, ultimately preparing the resident to take the American Board of Physical Therapy Specialties exam in Sports Physical Therapy.



The resident will receive mentored clinical practice in the physical therapy evaluation of spine and extremities (emphasizing the knee and shoulder), on field management of athletic injuries, and the rehabilitation of athletes off the field. There will also be the opportunity to work closely with sports orthopedic physicians, observe surgical procedures, as well as working with area professional hockey and basketball teams. An additional component of the residency will be collaborating on research with the Center for Orthopedic and Biomechanics Research Department at Boise State University.
